

CEMETERY AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 12, SEC. 12-6(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF PARK, OTTAWA COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO REGULATE THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF MONUMENT FOUNDATIONS.


PARK TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF OTTAWA, STATE OF MICHIGAN ORDAINS:


Section 1. Amendment to Section 12-6(c) of Chapter 12 - Cemeteries. Chapter 12, Sec. 12-6(c) of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Park, Ottawa County, Michigan, is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

- (c) *Monument foundations.* The footing or foundation upon which any monument is to be placed shall be four inches longer and four inches wider than the aboveground monument. Military stones at ground level may be placed without a footing. Maximum single grave footing size is 42 inches long by 14 inches wide. Maximum double grave footing size is 66 inches long by 18 inches wide. Maximum monument height above the ground surface is 40 inches high.

Section 2. Repeal. All resolutions, ordinances or parts of either in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of any such conflict, repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Park Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, on July 11, 2013, and is ordered to take effect on August 16, 2013, 30 days or more after publication in the *Holland Sentinel*, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township, pursuant to the provisions of Act 246 of the Public Acts of 1945, as amended.
