

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Ottawa Beach Road Pedestrian Improvements

Park Township, Ottawa County, Michigan

Park Township in conjunction with the Ottawa County Road Commission and the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) are proposing construction of pedestrian improvements at several sites on Ottawa Beach Road in Park Township. The improvements will consist of rapid flashing rectangular beacons, signing, pavement markings, and concrete sidewalk ramps.

Part of the project will be constructed on property owned by the Department of Natural Resources at 1827 Ottawa Beach Road, Holland, MI. A new sidewalk will be constructed on DNR land from the existing bike path for the proposed pedestrian crossing. An easement is being obtained for this use.

The project is funded through MDOT with federal funds. Potential impacts on recreational lands require that the public have an opportunity to provide comments on the project.
